

Public Health Corps Storytelling Project Q&A:

- **Question:** The Scope of Services states, “Vendor will also create a library of stories for each community” and “VENDOR will produce a story bank including appropriate media for each community”. Could FPHNYC please clarify whether this refers to 1 library that can be filtered/categorized by community, or 1 library per community? If 1 library per community, how is ‘community’ being defined (e.g., by TRIE neighborhood, by racial or ethnic group)?
 - **Answer:** TRIE Neighborhoods are defined as detailed on [this NYC.gov link](#). We are looking to create one library of resources for all CBOs that participate in this project.
- **Question:** Are all meetings with community partners and individual interviews (for story collection) expected to be conducted in person?
 - **Answer:** No. Some interviews may be hybrid, but we do expect in-person interaction with the CBOs for observation of their communications in action with the communities.
- **Question:** The Scope of Services states, “VENDOR will assess and evaluate the impact of each partner’s community engagement and support on the individual’s decision to get vaccinated or use other services recommended by the community partner”. Could FPHNYC please clarify whether the Vendor should conduct a program evaluation in addition to story collection and repository activities? The story collection should include questions about the support they received from the CBO as an indirect evaluation of the CBO.
 - **Answer:** Yes, the vendor will conduct a program evaluation.
