

Medicaid Expansion Outreach for Undocumented Older New Yorkers RFP Q&A Document

1. Would the version of Medicaid described in the RFP be the emergency version or the federal version with expanded benefits?
 - a. The version of Medicaid described in the RFP is not Emergency Medicaid. It is expanded coverage, analogous to the federal version, that will be paid through state funds and be made available through mainstream Medicaid Managed Care plans. This coverage includes most services - including primary and acute medical care, home care, prescription drugs, and nursing home care. A fact sheet for consumers is available [here](#). In order to qualify, individuals must have income and resources below the Medicaid thresholds, or within 138 percent of the federal poverty level.

2. With the version of Medicaid that participants will be guided to enroll in through this program, will enrollees have access to private medical providers?
 - a. Enrollees will have access to medical providers in their Medicaid Managed Care plan network. Medicaid Managed Care Plans in NYC are administered by Affinity by Molina Healthcare, Anthem Blue Cross and Blue Shield, HealthFirst, Emblem Health, MetroPlus, and United Healthcare.
