

# THE MATERNAL HOME COLLABORATIVE

The NYC Health Department's Maternal Home Collaborative is a pilot initiative where Black birthing people in Brooklyn have access to care that will address and reduce risks **before, during, and after pregnancy/birth**. We envision a world where pregnant people can easily access a system of race-conscious interventions.

## DID YOU KNOW?

Black women and birthing people in NYC are **4 times more likely** to die from a pregnancy-associated death than their white counterparts.

**72%**

of pregnancy-associated deaths among Black women and birthing people are **preventable**.

## THE GOAL:

Reduce maternal mortality rates **by 10%** by 2030

# INTERVENTIONS

## Maternal Medical Homes

**Clinical-based** maternal medical homes that coordinate **pregnancy, behavioral health, chronic, and social needs.**

## Pregnancy Support Professionals

Access to professionals that **bridge healthcare and community health**, including behavioral health support, lactation consultants, doulas, and community health workers.

## Maternal Mental Health

Launch NYC's **first intensive outpatient program for pregnant and postpartum people** and Child First, providing home visits for pregnant and parenting families facing mental health challenges.

## Neighborhood Stress-free Zones

**Community-based** stress-free zones with education, behavioral health, peer-to-peer community support, individual coaching, self-advocacy, and navigation to social service and material supports.
